Immersion Camp in South Korea

This three-week immersion camp in South Korea is part of the *Wisconsin American Village Summer Program*. We are committed to cross-cultural learning and fostering the holistic health of every student for the future global citizenship and leadership.

Program Details

- **Dates:** June 12–July 3, 2026
- **Registration Deadline:** April 15, 2026
- **Camp Location:** Hamyang, South Gyungsang Province
- **Eligibility:** Students in **middle school, high school** and **college**
- **Staff:** There will be a 1:6 staff-to-student ratio consisting of qualified educators and UW graduates from both the U.S. and South Korea.



Program Leadership and Experience

The director of this summer camp is Dong Su Lee, a retired United Methodist Church minister from Wisconsin. He has three decades of experience implementing this kind of international exchange program. He is currently a graduate student at UW-Madison.

Weekday Schedule

The daily schedule runs Monday through Friday. Students will attend cultural and academic classes in the morning, including the following:

- Korean language
- Music: percussion ensemble, samulnori
- Yoga: Kouksundo
- Food: gimbap and various types of kimchi

In the afternoon, students will go on field trips throughout the countryside:

- Schools and historic sites
- Temples and churches
- Farms and mountain trails
- Local concerts and performances



Weekend Schedule

During the three weekends, students will travel to see neighboring cities: including Seoul, the capital.

- Jeonju, South Korea
- Tsushima Island, Japan
